Mentors are ages 13 – 93. Youth must be 4-H or FFA exhibitors with goats, sheep, rabbits, or poultry. Adults can be parents, advisors, alumni who have experience showing one of those four species.

Mentors will be expected to volunteer their time and project animal (*adults-animals will be recruited for you*) for a special needs participant to handle and show in a showmanship class. Time is scheduled from 2pm-3pm for special needs participants to work with you, their mentor, in order to get to know their show animal and learn about care, grooming, and how to present their animal to the judge. After the one-on-one time, showmanship ‘judging ‘will begin!
