- 1. Contestants must be 15 years of age, or older as of Jan. 1, current year
- 2. A minimum of 1-year club work (not counting this year) is required. Previous Montgomery County Jr. Fair Kings and Queens are ineligible. Court members and finalists may re-apply.
- 3. Each entrant must submit an application. Entries are due:
 - Before July 5 to OSU Extension, 580 Calumet Lane, Dayton OH 45417
 - After July 5 and no later than 8:00pm July 10 to the Junior Fair Office at the Main Event Center,
 Fairgrounds
- 4. No limit on entries per club. Entrants must be a current member of a 4-H Club, FFA Chapter, or Girl Scout Troop with displays or animal entries at the current year Montgomery County Fair.
- 5. Queen contestants may wear dressy dresses. Formals are not required. King contestants must wear dress shirt and tie. Suit and/or jacket is not required. NO JEANS.
- 6. Scoring will be done on the following basis

Activities: Participation, Leadership, Achievements, Initiative 45% Poise & Personality 25% Individual & Public Interviews 30%

- 7. **Interviews will be scheduled between 2:15 4:30 p.m.** on Saturday of the Fair at the Main Event Center.
- **8.** All candidates will do public interviews and presentations on Saturday, July 16 at 6:00 p.m. The 2023 Jr. Fair King and Queen will be crowned following these presentations.

Responsibilities for 2023 Reign:

- 1. King, Queen, and Court will participate in the Montgomery County Fair opening day parade and ribbon-cutting ceremony 2023.
- 2. King and Queen will attend as many Junior Fair events as possible and assist with ribbon and trophy presentations as much as possible. Greeting the public and walking among Fair attendees is required daily. OSU Extension office staff will assist with scheduling.
- 3. King and Queen are to dress in appropriate manner to represent youth in the county. Jeans are not recommended. The King and Queen banners should be worn whenever possible. Appropriate manners are expected.
- 4. The Court will fill in for the King or Queen as needed and will be included as much as possible.
- 5. The reigning King and Queen will attend the contest next year and assist with the program.
- 6. The Queen will participate in the Ohio County and Independent Fair Queen and King Contest at the Ohio Fair Managers Conference in January, 2023. This information and form is due October, 2022.
