- 4-H Horse members must participate in 75% of their 4-H club meetings prior to the show.

For 4-H State Fair Qualification:

- You can only try to qualify with one animal; however, you may register up to 3 horses **by June 1, 2019**.
- You may select up to **6 classes** to attempt for State Fair Qualification. **Only one horse may be used for all PAS classes.** Show day, you must achieve a qualifying score in at least 2 classes to be eligible to show at the State Fair.

Eligibility for Participation:

- 4-H Horse members must participate in 75% of their 4-H club meetings prior to the show.
- Exceptions include: college, severe illness, etc. If severe circumstances exist, this must be put in writing and sent to the Extension Educator with this form.

DIVISIONS in 2019:

- **Hi-Point** - For those competitive showmen who own or lease a horse and wish to earn points toward the county "High Point" award. **Points are tallied on one horse.**
- **Novice** - For those showmen who do not wish to earn points in a particular class. These classes are for showmen who are trying to gain more experience and build their confidence in the show pen (includes members with borrowed horses)
- **First Year Showmanship** – for All AGE members if it is their FIRST TIME showing. If entered in 1st Year class, **cannot show in Novice nor in Hi-Point Classes.** Senior age members 14 & older are encouraged to show in Novice OR HI-Point.
- **AGES:** Senior – 14 to 18 as of January 1; Junior – 8 to 13 as of January 1.
- **Championship and Showman of Showman Classes:** if a member qualifies in more than one division, they can only enter these classes with one animal.
- **Hi-Point classes will be used to total points towards Junior and Senior Age Hi-Point Awards.** Hi-point is determined with one showmanship score and 5 additional scores from highest performance classes. **Points will be awarded:** Classes with **5 or more exhibitors** – 5 pts will be awarded for 1st place, 4 pts for 2nd place, 3 pts for 3rd place, 2 pts for 4th place, and 1 pts for 5th place; **Classes with 4 exhibitors**, 4 pts will be awarded for 1st place, 3 pts for second, etc. The same scoring pattern will follow for **classes with 3, 2, or 1 exhibitor(s):** First place exhibitor will receive the number of points that matches the number of entries in the class. **Bonus points will be earned for Championship classes:** Winning a championship class will add 2 bonus pts. to the high point score; winning a reserve championship will add 1 bonus point.
